Limited safety nets of family or community

Resulting in:

- Homelessness
- Incarceration
- Substance abuse
- Human trafficking





28% of the elderly live alone

- Loneliness and social isolation in seniors = poor mental and physical health
- Health effects of loneliness = smoking 15 cigarettes a day

An 80-year Harvard Study of Mental and Physical Well-being Relationships are vital to quality of life.

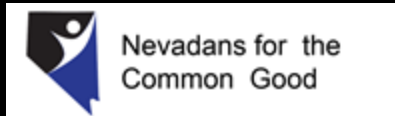
